

L and P1 Licence Exemption Relating to Competing in the 24 Hour Trial

Below is a guide to assist riders determine their eligibility to enter the event and items required for the event.

Follow SA guidelines, rules and laws relating to your individual situation to ensure that you are eligible to hold a Learners or Probationary licence. If you satisfy the requirements to hold a restricted learners permit, follow the following link to ensure that you satisfy the requirements.

Print out and complete the relevant exemption relating to your individual licence scenario.

Select the appropriate exemption for you depending on your current licence. You will need to carry this completed exemption with you throughout the event, we suggest laminating the form.

Contact 24hrtrial@gmail.com to be forwarded a document to use as 'supporting information' relating to competing in the event between the hours of 12 and 5am.

The competitor is responsible to ensure they meet the requirements relevant to their licence exemption. They need to complete an exemption form to receive the supporting document from MSA.

During the event, the rider will need to carry the following

- Completed exemption form
- Notice from MSA
- Copy of their entry form

Should a rider be pulled over by the Police, and it be found that they are on L or P1, and they do not have the above, they will be deemed to not be a competitor and charged accordingly. Please refer to the Supplementary Regulations for information relating to SAPOL traffic infringements.
