

## L and P1 Licence Exemption Relating to Entry in the 24 Hour Trial

Below is a guide to assist riders determine their eligibility to enter the event and items required for the event.

Follow SA government guidelines, rules and laws relating to your individual situation to ensure that you are eligible to hold a Learners Permit or Probationary licence. Information regarding this can be found in the following links:

If you are entering the 24 Hour Trial with a Learner's Permit or P1 Licence under 25 years of age, please follow the steps below to be eligible to enter.

1. Enter the 2024 HARDI 24 Hour Trial through Ridernet
2. Email The 24 Hour Trial Organising Committee at [compsec@24hrtrial.com](mailto:compsec@24hrtrial.com) with subject: Exemption Request.

Please provide the following details:

- a) Riders full name
  - b) MA Licence number
  - c) Civil driver's licence number
  - d) Civil Licence type – Learners Permit or P1 Provisional Licence
  - e) Registration number of the bike entered.
3. The Committee will then forward your exemption request to MSA who will sign the exemption form.
  4. A copy of the exemption form will be given to the competitor at Scrutineering on Friday 7th July.
  5. During the event, the rider will need to carry the following
    - Completed exemption form
    - Copy of their entry form

It is the responsibility of each competitor to follow this process. The committee will not pursue these details. Exemption requests are to be emailed to the committee no later than entry close - midnight **Friday 31st May. NO LATE EXEMPTION REQUESTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

During the event, should a rider be pulled over by the Police and it be found that they are on L or P1, and they do not have the above, they will be deemed to not be a competitor and may be charged accordingly. Please refer to the Supplementary Regulations, Section 4 for information relating to compliance with road laws.
